Printing

1. Open image in Photoshop
2. Go to Image Size and make sure the image is set to the desired size for printing
3. Select **File/Print**
4. In the Printer selection drop down menu Select the desired Epson Printer (4800/4000/7800)
5. Then click the paper size button and make sure the correct printer is selected next to format for. Then select the correct paper size to match the paper you are using and select the orientation of the image you are printing (Portrait/Landscape). Then click ok.
6. Under the Print box make sure **Document** is selected.
7. In color handling select **Photoshop Manages Colors**.
8. For Printer profile select the profile that corresponds with the paper you are printing with. For Epson Premium Luster you would select **Pro 4800 PLPP**
9. In the rendering intent menu select **Relative Colorimetric**
10. Make Sure **Black Point Compensation** is checked
11. Click Print
12. Select the menu titled Layout and select **Print Settings**
13. Under Page Setup select **Sheet** or **Roll** if you have roll paper loaded.
14. Under Media Type select the right paper type for the paper you are using. ex. **Premium Luster Photo Paper**
15. Under Color select **Color**
16. Under mode select **Advanced Settings**.
17. Under Print Quality select **Superfine – 1440**
18. Make sure High Speed in Unchecked!
19. Under the menu that now says Print Settings select **Printer Color Management**
20. Click **Off (No Color Adjustment)**
21. Make sure your paper is loaded correctly and press **Print**
